

# THE COLLEGE OF SURGEONS OF HONG KONG MANDATORY COURSES

FOR HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINEE ADMITTED BEFORE 1 JULY 2021

Higher Surgical Trainees (HSTs) are mandatorily required to attend the following courses and fulfil the required course requirements during their higher surgical training before **they are eligible for examination enrolment**.

### CARDIOTHORACIC SURGERY

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
- 2. Research Training Workshop

#### **GENERAL SURGERY**

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
- 2. Basic Laparoscopic Surgery Course
  - Must complete within the first 2 years of higher surgical training.
- 3. Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery Course
  - Pre-requisites: Basic Laparoscopic Surgery Course
  - Must complete within the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year of higher surgical training.
- 4. Research Training Workshop

#### NEUROSURGERY

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
- 2. Research Training Workshop

## PAEDIATRIC SURGERY

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
- 2. Paediatric Advanced Life Support Course
- 3. Research Training Workshop
- 4. Paediatric Safe Sedation Simulation Course for HSTs admitted from 1 July 2018 onwards

## PLASTIC SURGERY

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
  - Must complete the course run by the American College of Surgeons (ACS)
- 2. Advanced Burns Life Support Course or Emergency Management of Severe Burns
  - Must complete the course run by the Australian & New Zealand Burn Association
- 3. AO Basic Maxillofacial Course
  - Must complete courses on the principles of maxillofacial fracture treatment lasting should no less than 2 days of teaching with practical sessions
- 4. Microsurgery Skills Workshop
  - Must complete courses using live model with total course hours over 20, preferably with competency assessments after the course
- 5. Research Training Workshop

## **UROLOGY**

- 1. Advanced Trauma Life Support Course (ATLS)
- 2. Basic Laparoscopic and Endoscopic Urology Course
  - Must complete within the first 2 years of higher surgical training
- 3. Advanced Laparoscopic and Endoscopic Urology Course
  - Pre-requisites: Basic Laparoscopic and Endoscopic Urology Course
  - Must complete within the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year of higher surgical training.
- 4. Research Training Workshop
- 5. Critical Care Course for HSTs admitted from 1 January 2021 onwards

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

Trainees are required to submit the Official **Certificates** of the above courses to the College as evidence for completion when they apply for the Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination (for Plastic Surgery only).
