ELIGIBILITY FOR ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP/ HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINING/ EXAMINATION ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE/ FELLOWSHIP/FELLOWSHIP WITHOUT EXAMINATION

ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP

To be eligible for applying for the Ordinary Membership of The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (CSHK), applicants must fulfil all the following requirements:

1. **Fully registered** with The Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. Completed two-year Basic Surgical Training of the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges(HKICBSC) with satisfactory performance and proper rotations as prescribed in the Basic Surgical Training Curriculum
3. Passed the Membership Examination of HKICBSC(MHKICBSC Examination) held in Hong Kong
4. Completed satisfactorily all mandatory courses prescribed in the basic training programme
5. Application proposed and seconded by two paid-up College Fellows

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

A crossed cheque of HKD 8,000 (Entrance fee HKD 6,000 & Annual Subscription Fee HKD 2,000) made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**".

Applicants **MUST** apply for MCSHK within **THREE** years from the date they were eligible to be conferred. Applications submitted beyond this deadline will **NOT** be accepted.

HIGHER SURGICAL TRAINING

To enter Higher Surgical Training Programme of CSHK, applicants must fulfil all the following requirements:

1. Fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. Being an Ordinary Member of CSHK
3. Passed the Conjoint Selection Exercise of Higher Surgical Trainees held by the Hospital Authority of Hong Kong and CSHK (Please refer to the website of HA: http://www.ha.org.hk/visitor/ha_visitor_index.asp?Content_ID=1237&Dimension=100&Lang=ENG)
4. Obtained a Higher Surgical Training post from an approved training units/institutions in Hong Kong

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

- ✎ Curriculum Vitae (C.V.)
- ✎ A crossed cheque of HKD 1,800 (Annual Registration Fee) made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**".
- ✎ Certified true copy of Result Slip of other relevant examinations/qualifications (if any)

EXAMINATION ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE

Those who have fulfilled the training requirements including the duration of training, operational requirements and mandatory courses requirements but not yet passed the required examination will fall into the category of Examination Eligible Candidate (EECs). Clinical Attachment Programme (CAP) is a programme to which EECs will be attached for the purpose of maintaining surgical skills until passing the Fellowship Examination.

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

- ✎ Curriculum Vitae (C.V.)
- ✎ A crossed cheque of HKD 1,800 (Annual Registration Fee) made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**".
- ✎ Certified true copy of Result Slip of other relevant examinations/qualifications (if any)

FELLOWSHIP

To be eligible for applying for the Fellowship of CSHK, applicants must fulfil all the following requirements:

1. Fully registered with The Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. Complete 4/5 years of Higher Surgical Training of CSHK stipulated by the respective Specialty Boards with satisfactory training performance and fulfilment of training requirements prescribed in the Higher Surgical Training Programme
3. Fulfilled the operation requirement stipulated by the respective Specialty Boards as prescribed in the Guideline on Major Operation for Higher Surgical Trainee.
4. Passed the Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination/ Specialty Fellowship Examination (for Plastic Surgery only) held in Hong Kong or Singapore
5. Application proposed and seconded by two paid-up College Fellows

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

- ☞ Medical Registration Ordinance - Annual Practising Certificate
- ☞ Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination Result Slip/ Specialty Fellowship Examination Result Slip (for Plastic Surgery only)
- ☞ Certificate of Attendance of all mandatory courses required by the respective specialty board
- ☞ Certificate* for Clinical Proctorship Programme (For Higher Surgical Trainees in General Surgery/Urology)

**Awarded upon satisfactory completion of Clinical Proctorship Programme. The Coordinating Committee in Surgery of Hospital Authority will call for the list of qualified Higher Surgical Trainees for the issuance of the Certificates of Competency twice per year. Deadline for submission is normally at mid-May and mid-November.*

- ☞ Result Slip of Other relevant examinations/qualifications(if any)

- ☞ Index Operation Record Form (only applicable to Higher Surgical Trainees in General Surgery)

A crossed cheque of HKD 11,000 (Entrance fee HKD 8,000 and Annual Subscription Fee HKD 3,000) made payable to "The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong **Limited**".

Applicants **MUST** apply for FCSHK within **THREE** years from the date they were eligible to be conferred. Applications submitted beyond this deadline will **NOT** be accepted.

FELLOWSHIP WITHOUT EXAMINATION

All applicants must submit the following documents together with the Application Form in order to complete the application process:

1. One must be fully registered with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
2. One's application must be proposed by 5 paid-up fellows
